Barber's list of desirable adult behaviors:

- "Be happy with who she is.
- "Be happy with who others are.
- "Be well-adjusted, socialized and contribute toward society.
- "I want her to be kind and caring. I would be so embarrassed if she ever adopted some of the behaviors she's seen exhibited by some adults currently in leadership roles.
- "I want her to find the true man of her dreams.
- "I want her to be an honest person and not take credit for things she isn't responsible for.
- "I want her to be a liberal thinker and learn to be conservative financially.
- "I want her to be a role model because she is a good and honest person. I want her role models to be good and moral people and do the right thing.
- "I want her to have compassion and not attack everything that she doesn't believe in, but instead look for the good in all situations.
- "I want her to be successful in whatever she chooses and to be and smart enough to know that success is not measured in how much money you make [long, stern look at Trustees--who are volunteers].
- "And I want her to have an understanding that she is only one of 7 billion people; that she or her ideas are not better than or worse than any other person so that she has compassion for people."
